

9 Ye are cursed with a curse: for ye have robbed me, *even* this whole nation.

10 ¹Bring ye all the tithes into ²the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house, and prove me now herewith, saith the LORD of hosts, if I will not open you the ³windows of heaven, and ⁴pour you out a blessing, that *there shall not be room enough to receive it.*

11 And I will rebuke ¹the devourer for your sakes, and he shall not ²destroy the fruits of your ground; neither shall your vine cast her fruit before the time in the field, saith the LORD of hosts.

12 And all nations shall call you blessed: for ye shall be ¹a delightful-some land, saith the LORD of hosts.

13 ¹¶ Your words have been stout against me, saith the LORD. Yet ye say, What have we spoken *so much* against thee?

14 ¹Ye have said, It is vain to serve God: and what profit *is it* that we have kept ²his ordinance, and that we have walked ³mournfully before the LORD of hosts?

15 And now ¹we call the proud happy; yea, they that work wickedness ²are set up; yea, *they that tempt* God are even delivered.

16 ¹¶ Then they ²that feared the LORD ³spake often one to another: and the LORD hearkened, and heard *it*, and ⁴a book of remembrance was written before him for them that feared the LORD, and that thought upon his name.

17 And ¹they shall be mine, saith the LORD of hosts, in that day when I make up my ²jewels; and ³I will

18 ¹Then shall ye return, and discern between the righteous and the wicked, between him that serveth God and him that serveth him not,

CHAPTER 4.

¹ God's judgment on the wicked, ² and his blessing on the good. ⁴ He exhorteth to the study of the law, ⁵ and telleth of Elijah's coming and office.

¹FOR, behold, ²the day cometh, that shall burn as an oven; and all ³the proud, yea, and all that do wickedly, shall be ⁴stubble: and the day that cometh shall burn them up, saith the LORD of hosts, that it shall ⁵leave them neither root nor branch.

2 ¹¶ But unto you that ²fear my name shall the ³Sun of righteousness arise with healing in his wings; and ye shall go forth, and grow up as calves of the stall.

3 ¹And ye shall tread down the wicked; for they shall be ashes under the soles of your feet in the day that I shall do *this*, saith the LORD of hosts.

4 ¹¶ Remember ye the ²law of Mō-sēs my servant, which I commanded unto him ³in Hōr-ēb for all Is'-rā'ēl, with ⁴the statutes and judgments.

5 ¹¶ Behold, I will send you ²"Eli-jah the prophet" before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the LORD:

6 And he shall turn the heart of the fathers to the children, and the heart of the children to their fathers, lest I come and ²smite the earth with ³a curse.
