Warrant to the Secretarys office without Delay Given under my
hand at office the 10th of March 1779

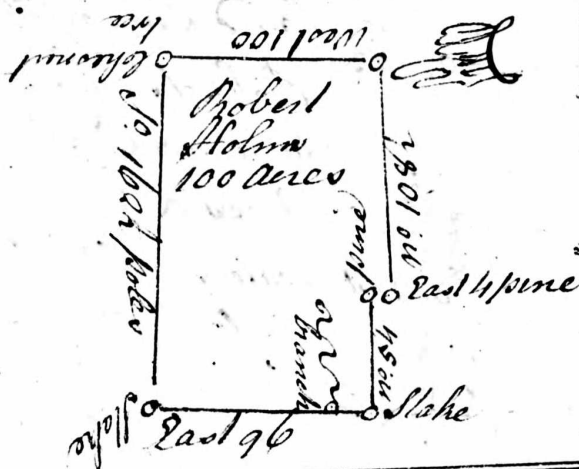
