FREEMAN, HOLMAN.

To wife Pereinah, slaves, etc., and half of the home plantation on Chickasaw creek, for life of widowhood, the other half to son John W., with slaves, etc.

To son Fleming another part of the land on Chickasaw creek adjoining Richard Aycock and James Freeman, slaves, etc.

To William W. Bibb certain slaves besides former gifts.

To "my beloved boy George B. Bibb" a slave as a token of remembrance.

To granddaughter Edny Freeman eldest child of son Fleming, a slave. Land in Green Co. Tenn., lot in Lisbon to be equally divided between wife and three children.

William W. Bibb and John W. Freeman, Excrs.

Signed April 26, 1817.
