### Deaths---- Mrs. George V Longcope

Mrs. Ruth Theobald Longcope, widow of George von S Longcope and a member of an old Maryland family distinguished in medicine and surgery, died at her home in Roland Park, Baltimore, on Friday. She was 86 years old. She was the daughter of the late Elisha and Frances Smith Theobald, the granddaughter of the late Dr. Nathn R Smith, former Professor of Surgery at the University of Maryland, the mother of Dr Warfield T Longcope, Professor of Medicine at Johns Hopkins Medical School and physician in chief of Johns Hopkins Hospital and the sister of the late Dr. Samuel Theobald. Mrs Longcope is remembered here, having for years spent the summer at Braddock Heights.

Dr. Nathan Smith , originator of important surgical technique many years ago and the founder of the medical schools of Dartmouth and Yale, was Mrs. Longcope's great-grandfather.

Surviving Mrs. Longcope are three sons, George Longcope of Washington, D.C.; Alan Longcope and Dr Warfield T Longcope of Baltimore and one daughter, Miss Frances Longcope.
