Mr. Bowie:

Your genealogical work is of great interest. Thanks so, so much for all that you've put together.

I'm writing to offer some desiderata which may or may not be of any use to you. I found The Book of Bowie while researching my deWolf line, but I'm not sure how much allied information might interest you at all. Ah, well... Perhaps better to have too much than too little.

I'm a direct descendant of James deWolf. A few years ago, I furnished some information about my family in Maryland; some of which has been incorporated into The Book of Bowie. May I add a few notes, please:

Some stray notes, if of any interest/use:

I'm attaching a very small booklet, privately printed, entitled " A Little Girl of 1812". It contains some rather fun deWolf information and lore.

1. A note in your entry for Frederick Lewis Wehr (my mother's father) suggests that he and his wife Nancy deWolf Theobald Wehr had no children. They had 2 children: Nancy deWolf Wehr Smith Niermann (my mother) and Frederick T. Wehr (my uncle). I attach obituaries for both. Both were outlived by their mother.
2. Nancy deWolf Theobald Wehr's mother was Edna Dulany Theobald. Your Book does not seem to indicate her lineage. Edna Dulany Theobald (my great-grandmother) was the daughter of John Mason Dulany and Emily Chatard Higginbotham Dulany. Emily Chatard Higginbotham Dulany's mother was named Frances Claggett, whose Claggett husband (I don't, at the moment, know his first name) was a lineal descendant of Thomas John Claggett, the first Bishop of the Episcopal Diocese of Maryland and the first bishop of the Episcopal Church to have been consecrated on U.S. soil. (SEE: https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Thomas_John_Claggett) I attach 2 pages of handwritten notes made by my grandmother, which provide information about both the Claggett and Theobald families.

Perhaps some of this information will be of interest and/or use. If I can help in any way relative to Maryland folks, please let me know and I'll do my best.
