My sister Dot has written me that you still live in Ft Smith. I remember seeing you last in New York about 1928 at Bonnie Lee's apartment on Riverside drive. How many of your family are living? My brother Edwin lives in Phoenix Ariz. Dot lives in Hendersonville N.C. Bonnie Lee is at Winter Park Fla. Le Moyne passed away in 1953 at Bward NC. I have lived in California since 1923. I have two children and six grandchildren. My two grandsons Jack III + Eric are the last hope of the Farrior line. Edwin my brother has worked on the genealogy of the family for thirty five years and then turned the job over to me. We have traced the family through several states to the first Farrior in America James Farrior born about 1706. We have tied in all the branches excepting yours. I would appreciate any help you can give me by filling in the back of this letter and also your family sheet. I don't remember your Father but remember your Mother real well. Do you happen to have any old pictures of the family that I could have copied for my genealogical album? All of our pictures were destroyed when our home burned in Dardanelle in 1915. I found a census report on William B Farrior in Dardanelle 1870 age 53 and thought that might be your grandfather. When I complete the pedigree chart which should be soon will be happy to send you a copy if you desire. As I remember you had a brother Clarence; did he have a family and where do they live? I also remember a Julia, Jenny, Stella, Olive and you. Do you remember my grandmother Julia? I hoped you might have a picture of her husband E. W. Farrior Sr. Everyone used to exchange pictures and we had hundreds but now we have nothing. Thank you Lillian for any help you can give me. I hope this letter finds you in good health.
